Announcement of the Wolfgang von Kempelen Prize for Computing Science History

The Austrian Society for Computing Science History (ÖGIG), the Austrian Computer Society (ÖCG) and the Federal Ministry for Transport, Innovation and Technology (BMVIT) are awarding a prize for Computing Science History in two categories, Science and Art (including journalistic intermediation). The prizes of a total value of 10.000 Euros will be awarded for Computing Science History once every two years.

The early, pioneering years of information science were eventful. The time is now ripe for reflection. One route towards a deeper understanding of information science is that of a scientific and artistic exploration of its history. No matter how hard science may strive to achieve objectivity, if it does not include the human aspect in its considerations it can never be understood in its full breadth.

The awarding criteria

In both categories the prizes will be awarded to submissions which exemplify a creative approach to dealing with either the work of major computer scientists, or of a corresponding personality, or with a relevant concept concerning the tensions between computer science and society.

The work is to be sent quintuplicate to the address below, together with the completed application form, a brief description of the work submitted and relevant photographic documentation by January 15, 2007:
